




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Versioning

States in EUDAMED for a version

Updates through create new version:

All history of changes will be in EUDAMED to guarantee traceability on changes

A registered version will be always kept (cannot be changed or deleted), only version in draft can be directly updated and deleted

Discard option for logical delete in case of mistakes (data are kept but with a new state: Discarded)

Version has a state assigned by EUDAMED to determine the step in the registration workflow

Mainly you have the state Draft and Registered, but also Submitted, Discarded ... depending on the item and module.

Depending on the state, actions are possible or not

State and Status are not the same thing







Notification

At Actor level and at user level (optional)

On user interface and by email (not in Playground)

For action and for information

Data exchange

Machine to machine XML upload/download (M2M) requires Access point link (max 2/per Actor) with justification (PLG), proof of testing (Prod) and 3rd party agreement when applicable to be approved by EC

Bulk XML upload/download

Public download API Json format

Availability depends on Actor role and data







Actor:

an organisation/legal entity that is or must be registered in EUDAMED due to legal obligations to provide data and/or to access EUDAMED content

Actor:

an organisation/legal entity that is or must be registered in EUDAMED due to legal obligations to provide data and/or to access EUDAMED content

Note!

- Competent authorities and designating authorities are registered by the Commission
- Notified bodies are registered from data in NANDO
- An actor can have only one role










Manufacturers (MF): register themselves, manage mandates with their authorised representative(s) when applicable, register their devices (and SS(C)Ps' translations) and related post-market surveillance and vigilance reports



Importers (IM): register themselves, associate themselves to the non-EU manufacturers for which they place devices on the market and can check those non-EU manufacturers and devices data entered into EUDAMED



Authorised representatives (AR): register themselves, participate to the registration of the non-EU manufacturer, participate to the management of the mandates, register vigilance reports when applicable and check the information provided by the non-EU manufacturers



System/procedure pack producers (PR): register themselves and their systems/procedure packs.







Single Registration Number (SRN)


Manufacturers, importers and authorised representatives placing Regulation devices on the market



All other actors

Format of the Actor ID/SRN for economic operators

Note: Competent authorities, Designating authorities and notified bodies have a different format for their Actor ID.









Non-EU MF must have an Authorised Representative (this does not apply to non-EU SPPPs)	Economic operators must be validated by a responsible CA	
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
The responsible CA can be changed in case of change of address For NB, the responsible DA is determined from the data in NANDO To be considered as 'registered', economic operators must:

- have a validated actor registration request
- have an Actor ID/SRN









The responsible CA is the one of your Actor location or the one of your AR (for non-EU MF). For non-EU SPP producers, CA is determined by where the first SPP will be placed on the market. There is a duplicate check with warning message for both requester and CA validator







- > Actor role
- Organisation name (and optionally abbreviated name)
- Organisation identifiers (VAT, EORI, National trade register, if applicable)
- Organisation address
- Authorised representative (for non-EU MF)
- Responsible CA (depending on address)
- Public contact details
- Contact details for CAs (non-public)
- Person Responsible for regulatory compliance (only for MF and AR)
- Signed agreement annex (non-public)
- Organisation identification document (optional, non-public)
- Sub-contractor information (if applicable, non-public)





LAA:	LUA:
Advisable to have two per Actor	Manages users for the Actor
They manage actor's data	
User who submitted the actor registration request is the first LAA	
First NB LAA to be approved by DA	

Note: users (LAA, LUA included) may not manage their own access rights/profile, any change of profile requires a change request to be approved by another LAA or LUA





Profiles available for all Actor roles

- Local Actor administrator (LAA): Manage Actor data and Access point for M2M data exchange and has the rights of LUA
- Local user administrator (LUA): Manage user access requests for the Actor and has the rights of Viewer/Validator/Mandate manager/Verifier/Linker
- Viewer: May view all his/her Actor data and all public data from other Actors


Specific profiles for Actor roles

- Validator: For CA users for validating Actor registration request and has the rights of a Viewer
- Mandate manager: For non-EU MF users for managing mandates with ARs and has the rights of a Viewer
- Verifier: For AR users to verify Actor registration requests and has the rights of a Viewer
- Linker: For importer users to link their Actor to non-EU MF and has the rights of a Viewer









Profiles are modules related, which means you don't have necessarily the same profiles for the different modules. Profiles are hierarchical, it means a higher profile will always contain the rights of the profile(s) below it.
